7. Essential Spares (Recommendation)

To reduce interruptions and laundry pressure, we recommend keeping **5** of the following daily essentials where practical:

- Underwear, socks, plain daily shirts, face towels.
(Items with specific quantities above — e.g., tracksuits x7 — should be supplied as listed.)



8. Important Notes (Labelling, Care & Rules)

- **Label everything.** Sewn or iron-on name labels are strongly recommended. Unlabelled items are difficult to trace.
- **Communal supplies:** Washing powder and toilet-roll packs will be collected and stored centrally for hostel use only; do **not** expect these to remain in individual rooms. Please hand the items to the hostel matron or school office on arrival or no later than two weeks before term starts.
- **Approved colours & styles only.** Only specified colours are permitted (grey tracksuits, navy or black plain shirts). Jeans must be plain and un-distressed. No fashion logos, slogans or decorative rips.
- **Footwear rules.** Bathroom slippers and hostel sneakers must be **plain black or plain white** and not fashionable. Slippers are for bathroom use only.
- **Hygiene & consumables.** Washing powder and toiletries are listed by term/month — parents should replenish as needed. Check expiry dates and sealed packaging before handing items in.
- **Electronics & valuables.** The hostel is not responsible for loss of valuables. Avoid sending expensive electronics. Mobile phones/electronics are not allowed
- **Prohibited items.** No candles, open-flame devices, hotplates, illicit substances, electronic devices or dangerous items. Battery kettles and cooking appliances are not allowed in dorms.
- **Medication.** All medication must be declared to the hostel matron in original packaging with written instructions from parent/guardian.
- **Condition & maintenance.** Parents will be liable for damage to school property; dorm inspections will be conducted regularly.

9. Do's & Don'ts (Quick Reference)

Do

- Do label all items clearly and permanently.
- Do supply the specified colours and quantities.
- Do buy durable, easy-care fabrics and machine-washable items.
- Do inform the hostel of allergies or medical needs in writing.

Don't

- Don't send torn, ripped, or fashion-distressed clothing.
- Don't send expensive or sentimental valuables without a clear reason.
- Don't send prohibited electrical appliances or open-flame items.
- Don't rely on the hostel to identify unlabelled property.
